



MRG Tool and Die Scholarship

What is the MRG Scholarship?

MRG Tool and Die is offering two full-tuition scholarships to recent high school graduates who are interested in pursuing a career in advanced manufacturing, specifically toolmaking and machining.

Each scholarship award will cover the costs of over \$11,000 in tuition and fees for South Central College's Computer Integrated Machining Diploma program (66 credits). In addition, students will have the opportunity to practice skills learned in the classroom while working on the job site at MRG Tool and Die.

The MRG scholarship will be awarded each semester provided students

- Earn a semester-based G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher (4.0 scale)
- Actively participate and attend all classes
- Model MRG's company values of *Integrity, Collaboration, and Innovation*

***These requirements will be reviewed regularly and formally acknowledged by MRG paying the next semester's tuition directly to SCC. (Program related tuition only.)**

What are the benefits of the MRG Scholarship?

- Financial support from MRG is provided through tuition assistance: graduate debt-free*
- Part-time employment at MRG while in school (20 hours/week during classes)
- Flexible work schedule based on student's class schedule
- Valuable hands-on training directly related to the student's education
- Opportunity to develop greater overall experience in the advanced manufacturing career field
- Potential for a full-time job offer prior to graduation

What are the requirements to apply for a MRG Scholarship?

- Current or recent high school graduate
- Live within a 30-mile radius of Faribault, MN
- 18 years of age or older at time of award
- Successfully be admitted to South Central College
- Complete and submit the MRG Scholarship application
- Complete a professional interview with MRG and be selected as a final candidate
- Meet and maintain a GPA of 3.0 (4.0 scale) or higher and actively participate in all courses at SCC
- Maintain minimum workload of 20 hours per week at MRG Tool and Die

What do I have to include in my application?

- Completed MRG Scholarship Application
- Unofficial college transcript (current student) or high school transcript (admitted student)
- Resume
- Proof of admittance to South Central College
